	"Informational Health: An Integrated Framework for the Analysis and Design of Information Spaces" Erina Murata (The University of Tokyo) Fujio Toriumi (The University of Tokyo)					
	Abstract: In today's information society, information spaces have become an indispensable foundation of everyday life. However, it remains difficult to objectively understand the dynamics within these spaces. While information spaces serve as critical infrastructures that support the free flow and exchange of information, their attention-economy-driven structures also give rise to phenomena such as filter bubbles and echo chambers, thereby embedding social risks including the spread of misinformation, disinformation, and online harassment. This tutorial positions "Informational Health" as an integrated framework for addressing these challenges. In particular, it focuses on network structures, information transformation across media platforms, large language models (LLMs), and users' emotional responses. By integrating these perspectives, the tutorial discusses the approaches for evaluating and supporting healthier information environments. Participants will gain an interdisciplinary understanding of how information environments can be analyzed, evaluated, and designed from the perspective of Informational Health.					

Speakers Bio.

Fujio Toriumi

Fujio Toriumi is a Professor at the Graduate School of Engineering, The University of Tokyo. He received his Ph.D. in Engineering from the Department of Mechanical and Control Systems Engineering, Tokyo Institute of Technology, in 2004. He became an Associate Professor at the Graduate School of Engineering, The University of Tokyo, in 2012, and has held his current position since 2021. His research interests include computational social science and the social applications of artificial intelligence technologies, particularly the empirical analysis of social phenomena in information spaces. He has also served as Vice President of the Japanese Association for Computational Social Science.

Masaki Chuiyo

Masaki Chuiyo is an Assistant Professor at the Graduate School of Engineering, The University of Tokyo. He received his master's degree in 2020 and his Ph.D. in Fusion Science in 2023 from the Japan Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (JAIST). He joined his current position in 2023. His research interests include computational social science and complex networks. In this tutorial, he will cover network-based analyses of social media.

Hirohiko Suwa

Hirohiko Suwa is an Associate Professor at the Graduate School of Science and Technology, Nara Institute of Science and Technology (NAIST). He received his Ph.D. in Engineering from The University of Electro-Communications. His research interests include data mining, social media analysis, and recommender systems, with a focus on analyzing human behavior and social phenomena through information science approaches.

He has also conducted research in ubiquitous computing and social information systems, addressing social issues through the collection, analysis, and application of real-world data. In this tutorial, he will explain the foundations of semantic generation by large language models (LLMs) and discuss their role in information spaces from the perspective of Informational Health.

Dongwoo Lim

Dongwoo Lim is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Sociology, Faculty of Sociology, Kansai University. He received his Ph.D. in Social Information Studies from The University of Tokyo in 2023. His research lies in the fields of media studies and computational social science, particularly focusing on social media analysis and user behavior. His recent work investigates how information is propagated and reconstructed across different media platforms, as well as how content formats and contexts change during this process. He is especially interested in the characteristics and social impacts of information circulation across online platforms. In this tutorial, he will discuss information transformation processes across media and explain the role of media platforms in understanding information environments.

Erina Murata

Erina Murata is a doctoral student affiliated with the Graduate School of Engineering, The University of Tokyo, and the Graduate School of Human Sciences, Waseda University. Her research focuses on psychological traits and social emotions in social media environments. In this tutorial, she will address emotional transitions across social media and mass media.
